Bylaw No. 5 - 05

A BYLAW TO REMOVE ABANDONED VEHICLES

The Council of the Village of Quill Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. A vehicle is deemed to be abandoned if:
 - the vehicle has been left or placed on a street, public place or land or building owned or controlled by the urban municipality for 10 days or more; and
 - after reasonable inquiry, the owner of the vehicle cannot be ascertained.

2. The Council may order that a vehicle that is deemed to be abandoned by virtue of Section (1) be removed from the place where it is abandoned and sold, destroyed or otherwise disposed of as Council may decide.
